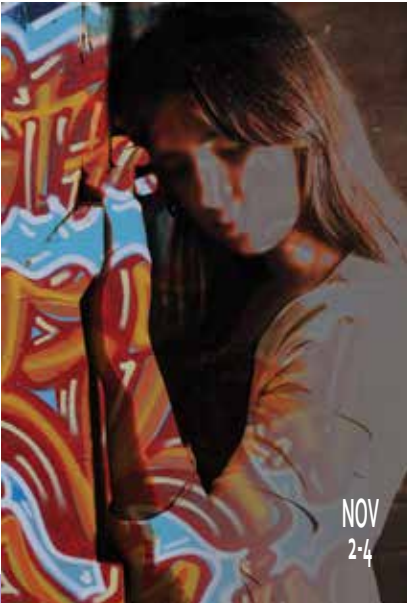
Governing Alice

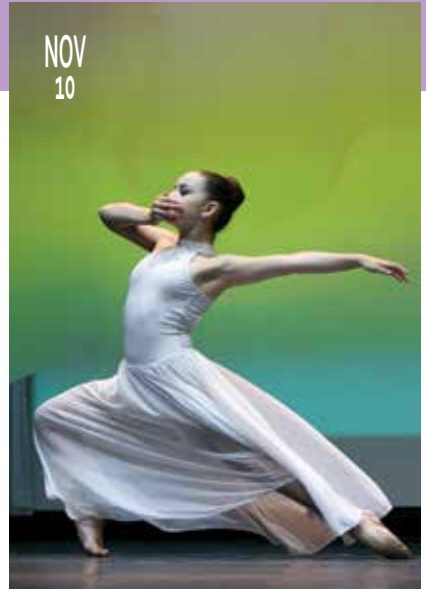


Pieces of Me

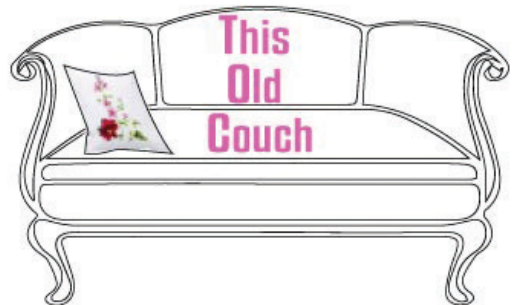
This Old Couch

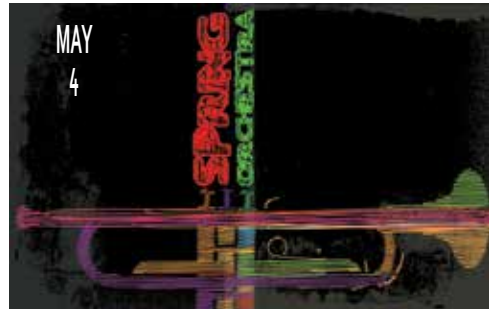

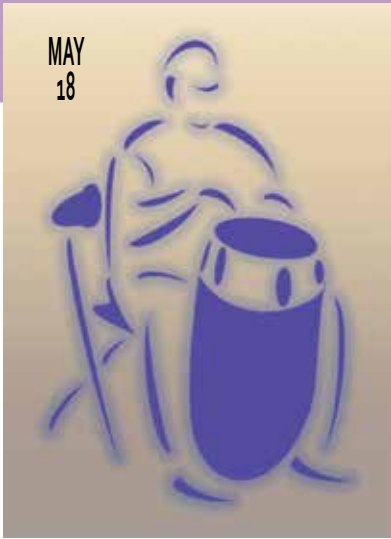
